

I. Roll call

- A. Quorum is present.

II. Financials

- A. Year end financials were discussed. Noted April shortage and the September increase in revenue due to Covid and the Gamaliel Cup being moved.

III. State Shoot

- A. It was put before the board and approved that the 2021 Tennessee State Shoot dates be changed to September 16-19th. The change should help with attendance at the State Shoot since the Southeast Regional falls on the same date.

IV. Shoot Flyers

- A. It was noted that State Shoot flyers would be mailed out sooner in the upcoming year.

V. State Shoot Voting

A. It was agreed upon that the ballots would be printed and given to any state member present at the shoot who had met the target requirements and did not get an email to vote.

VI. By Laws

It was brought up by Don Padgett that not all membership received access to the updated By Laws that were posted to the T.S.C.A website. These were posted and password protected since they have the year end financials attached. Melissa agreed that she would send out another email to the general membership so that they would have access.

VII. Points Race & Additional Funds

- A. It was mentioned by William that we had additional funds in the bank that he would like to see distributed back to the shooters. The choice was put before the board to add it back into the State Shoot or add it to the Points Race shoots in hopes to increase participation.
- B. Thomas Moncrief put forward a motion to allot \$6000.00 dollars to be budgeted to the 12 Points Race shoots.
 - a. Chris Schmeisser seconded the motion.
 - b. The motion passed.
- C. Thomas Moncrief motioned that there would be \$500.00 per Points Race Shoot to be drawn randomly from the entrants that pre registered for the shoot one week in advance and were present at the event.
 - a. Chris Schmeisser seconded the motion.
 - b. The motion passed.

VIII. Sub Junior/ Junior Participation

- A. William put forth a request for help increases youth participation in the T.S.C.A shoots.
- B. Don Padgett agreed that we needed to increase the numbers and encouraged board members to reach out to the youth to help them with rides etc.
- C. The idea was brought forward that to increase youth participation in the Points Race events that they would create a separate leader board for the Sub Junior and Junior Shooters. The top five from each division would be able to participate in a shoot off at the Tennessee State Shoot for 5 flats of shells.
- D. Thomas Moncrief put forth the motion that the Youth leaderboard be created with a shoot off held at the State Shoot on Saturday night for the top five contenders from each division with prizes given at the end of the shoot off.
 - a. Chris Schmeisser seconded.
 - b. The motion Passed.

IX. T.S.C.A T.B.D Shoot

- A. The idea was brought forth of an Iron Man Style event that would include 5 clubs over 2 days with 5 hundred targets thrown.
- B. Thomas Moncrief brought forth a motion to involve T.S.C.A in the T.B.D Shoot.
 - a. Chris Schmeisser seconded the motion.
 - b. The motion passed.

X. Monthly Newsletter

A. The idea of a monthly newsletter was brought forward to the board. This idea was scratched because the effort it would take to follow through with this process would be greater than the return.

XI. Donation for the 2021 Regional

- A. William informed the board that Harvey Shwartz had asked every state association to donate \$500.00 to their Regional banquet on Saturday night. The board discussed at length whether or not this would be of any value to the board and if it would benefit the T.S.C.A shooters.
- B. Thomas Moncrief put forward the motion that the T.S.C.A would give \$500.00 for the Saturday night banquet at the 2021 Regional at the Meadows contingent on the fact that William Schmeisser would make contact with the individual State Associations in the Region to ensure that all were participating in the donation process.
 - a. Chris Schmeisser seconded the motion.
 - b. The motion passed.

X. Calendar of Events

A. William put forth the idea of creating a calendar of events to be sent out to the shooters listing the shoots for the upcoming year. This would also be made available online and as a printable form for an individual to download. The board members agreed this was a good idea.

XI. A.F.S

- A. It was brought forth to the board about getting the clubs involved in throwing A.F.S. events in conjunction with the N.S.C.A registered events. The board thought this would be an excellent idea to get more participation and to get more registered targets thrown for the state.

XII. Instagram

- A. William mentioned the idea of linking the Instagram account and Facebook account together to increase our media presence. Melissa said she would link the accounts. The idea to get users to add a hashtag to their pictures so they could be posted was also mentioned.

XIII. ScoreChaser

- A. William mentioned that the board might want to try and encourage clubs to convert to the ScoreChaser system so that all the clubs would be working with the same format. The board decided that this should be left up to the clubs to decide what program would work best for them.

XIV. T.S.C.A Membership Cost for Clubs

- A. The idea was brought forward to reinstate a member fee for clubs wishing to be a T.S.C.A member club. This amount would not exceed the National amount of \$100.00. It was brought forward that this might not be cohesive with our bylaws and should be looked into before further discussion.
The discussion was tabled until further research on the matter could be done.

XV. Further Business

- A. William asked if any other board member or T.S.C.A member had anything else to discuss. No further items were presented.
- B. Thomas Moncrief made the motion to adjourn the meeting.
 - a. Chris Schmeisser seconded the motion.
 - b. The meeting was adjourned.
